This is a course that covers the technical aspects required to take a group of people on multi day overnight hiking experience off trail and at altitude. The hands-on approach will keep learners constantly active, and it is designed to lay a solid foundation in both safety and technical skills. If the principles taught this course are adhered to, and continued with diligence, it will serve as an excellent preparation to ensure successful mountain walking instructor assessment. Please Note this course is not for someone with no or little mountain walking experience or with a limited scope, but with extensive experience in multiple locations.

2 full days for the assessment which will also be in a mountain location (MDT assessment is not included in training)

Course Outline

This is a 3 day and two evening lecture course where we will equip mountain walking candidates to be able to take their clients on this outdoor experience safely. We cover with theory an intro on mountain gear (care and purchasing), navigation and map work; where the learner will be able to navigate with a map, GPS and compass in difficult environment with limited visibility. We will also cover dealing with crossing flooded rivers and handling steep ground. There is also a high altitude and overnight camping component. You will also be taken through the basics of outdoor ethics and environmental standards required, as well as legal aspects of hiking with groups such as land access and liability, and group management. Lastly they are taught about all potential mountain hazards and how to handle a mountain emergency, the correct procedures, who to contact, and what not to do. A fair degree of physical activity will be involved so some level of fitness is essential. It is also required for the academic component, competence in communication and numeracy equivalent to NQF level 4 (Grade 10)
